

**Even the smallest actions can have a big impact** — Take a moment today to think of Hisham and his fellow students in Jordan by folding a little paper shape of your own.

Follow these instructions to transform a small square of paper into a paper dove as a symbol of your support.

**LEGEND:**

- — — Fold line
- Crease line
- ↷ Direction of fold



**TIP:**


Look at the next step to see what the finished fold should look like.

**Ex:** After completing Step 2 your paper should look like the image in Step 3.


**Start:** Begin with the square of paper on a flat surface, coloured side facing down.




**Step 1**  
Take the bottom corner and fold it up to meet the top corner, then unfold, creating a crease.




**Step 2**  
Take the right corner and fold it over to meet the left corner, creating a triangle.




**Step 3**  
Take the left corner of the triangle and fold it about halfway over to the right.




**Step 4**  
Fold the top flap back to the left as shown, exposing the inside of the paper.




**Step 5**  
Take the top point and bring it down to meet the bottom point, using the crease you created in Step 1 as a guide. This creates the body of the dove.




**Step 6**  
Fold the top flap up at an angle, as shown on the fold line above. This creates a wing.




**Step 7**  
Flip the piece over.




**Step 8**  
Fold the remaining wing up to meet the first wing at the same angle.



**Step 9**  
Almost done! Fold the right tip of the dove's body down to create a crease, as shown.



**Step 10**  
Using the crease as a guide, fold the tip of the paper inward to create the dove's head.



**Finish!**
