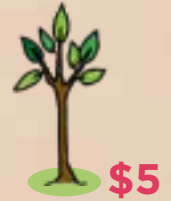
# Tiny Hearts

## Pair of goats

Goats meet many needs — their milk, cheese and meat add healthy protein to diets, and their young can be sold to pay for education, housing and healthcare, or given to other families in the community.

In regions where flooding has totally covered farmland, farmers are rapidly adapting and fishing on what used to be their farmland. Provide a fishing kit so a family who has lost their farm can start on a source of income and food.

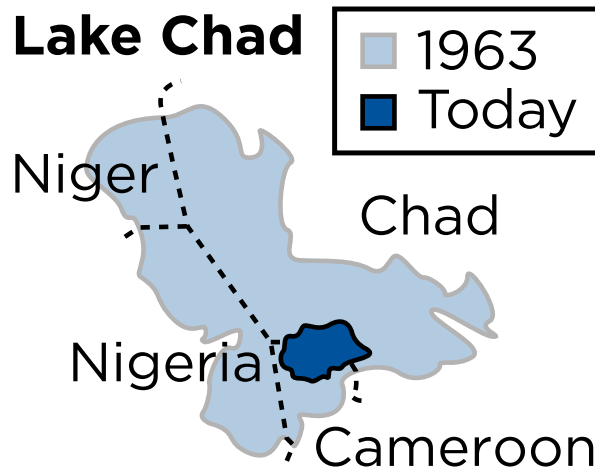
Around Lake Chad, farmers are fighting back to stop an entire ecosystem from unraveling. We think they can win, but they need your help.
