YOUR IMPACT SO FAR



43 Eco-Clubs formed in local schools, each made up of 10 students (5 girls, 5 boys). These clubs are now leading the way in promoting environmental education, from climate change awareness to composting and creating school orchards!



139 Women's Groups have been formed or revitalized. These include a women's group for the fight against gender-based violence (GBV), women's leaders' groups, and women's market gardeners' groups, which will empower women within their communities.

27 Farmer Field School Sites are now active, training farmers in sustainable nature-based solutions (NBS). Meanwhile, 47 new market gardens are improving nutrition and income for families.



Over 9,000 participants (approx. 5,300 women, 3,300 men, 430 boys and 220 girls) across 69 villages are already being engaged through this project. These individuals are active members of groups that focus on beneficial practices such as peacebuilding and environmental stewardship.
