Devastating floods in Jonglei State uprooted the lives of over 400,000 people, forcing them to flee to higher ground or neighboring areas.

The floodwaters transformed farmlands, leaving families with no choice but to fish on land they once harvested.

Discrimination and gender-based violence excluded many women from income-generating activities and decision-making, leaving them with limited access to resources.
