This summer, Pakistan experienced three times more rainfall than its average monsoon season, leaving a third of the country under water.

Flooding and landslides destroyed homes, crops, health centres, and infrastructure. Rivers breached their banks, and major dam reservoirs overflowed.

With this came an increased risk of malaria, dengue fever and other diseases.

Millions of people across the country were left needing emergency care and provisions.

Thanks to your fast and generous response, vulnerable people in Pakistan will receive the critical support that they so desperately need.

Families will be given food, shelter, and mosquito nets, with further support given to improve and maintain water, sanitation and hygiene. Livestock owners will receive feed and vaccinations, and farmers will be given seeds and fertilizers to help grow important vegetables and crops.

Pregnant women will be provided with essential medical assistance, and people who have suffered significant losses will receive psychosocial support. There will also be safeguarding measures implemented to protect women and children against sexual exploitation and abuse as families and communities continue to recover from this crisis.
