On February 6th, during the early hours of the morning, earthquakes hit the border region of Türkiye and Syria.

A lack of security and support structures hindered safety and recovery, as more than 500,000 Syrians were forced from their homes.

Many thousands of people in the northwest of the country have faced a growing humanitarian crisis.

Following the first phase emergency response to the earthquake back in February, our partners are now focused on supporting those families who do not have a home to return to, and who have lost so much. The psycho-social and mental health support that is made possible by your generosity is of utmost importance, underpinning rehabilitation for those affected by the tragedy.

The needs of victims can vary as the situation develops, and your gift enables us and our partners to respond flexibly and efficiently; a current priority is to focus on WASH (water, sanitation and hygiene) and community awareness/training in earthquake safety, health and hygiene (including cholera prevention).

We shall continue to assess the mid-term and long-term needs of those affected, and we will provide more updates as we receive them.
